- One-on-one contact between an adult and a Scout is prohibited.
- Privacy of youth is respected.
- Inappropriate use of cameras and imaging and digital devices is prohibited.
- No secret organizations.
- No hazing or bullying.
- Youth leadership is monitored by adult leaders.
- Discipline must be constructive.
- Appropriate attire is required for all activities.
- Members are responsible for acting according to the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Units are responsible for enforcing Youth Protection policies.

UNIFORM ALWAYS REQUIRED

The pack is divided into smaller groups called dens.



The Lion Rank is for Youth who are in Grade K



No matter what age or grade a youth joins Cub Scouting, they must earn their Bobcat badge before rank advancement



The Tiger rank is for Youth who are in first grade, age 6



The Wolf rank is for youth who are in second grade, age 7



The Bear rank is for youth who are in third grade, age 8



The Webelo rank is for youth who are in fourth grade, age 9



The AOL rank is for youth who are in sixth grade, age 10

**Parents or Guardians must attend meetings with scout.
Lion and Tiger Ranks require Parent or Guardian Partners
ALL PACK RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED!**

In order to complete a rank a Scout needs to attend no Less than 75% of meetings held!

Special circumstances are coordinated with Den leaders for advancement

All funds are recorded by our Treasurer. Reports are presented at monthly committee meetings

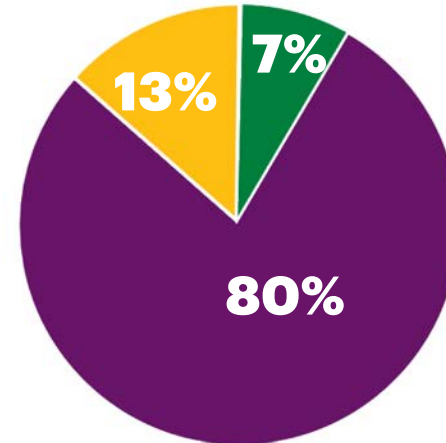
